What could **fill the void left by public and private third-party payers**, who leave suicidal patients to their own fate outside hospitals, without the intervention of **solidarity**?

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

The psychiatry department of Hôtel-Dieu de France is organizing a fundraising campaign this May 2024 to support patients suffering from mental disorders during these challenging times for our society.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide adequate and equitable care to all our patients due to the high cost of hospitalizations compared to the limited incomes of the majority of those who seek our help every day. The involvement of public and private third-party payers is either absent or lacking efficacy especially since the economic crisis since 2019.

The USJ Foundation, the philanthropic arm of the Saint Joseph University of Beirut, has been collaborating for several years with its affiliated hospital, Hôtel-Dieu de France, to address gaps in various health-related areas. Currently, there is ongoing collaboration with the psychiatry department of Hôtel-Dieu de France, as this is a problem that worsens over time and can only be solved with the contribution of individuals capable and willing to help our patients.
